

FIELD TRIAL PLACEMENTS 1963

In an effort to make the charts of field trial placements more meaningful, and at the same time to conserve space, they have been condensed as much as possible, and will run in successive issues.

† means Bench Champion, § means field Champion, and * is Dual Champion. The first column contains the dogs name, his owner (handler). Next are his sire and dam. Dogs will be listed in the region in which they were principally campaigned. In all age dogs the next number is the number of previous wins. (Not mentioned in puppy-derby chart.) The last column has S-for spring, and F-for fall. This is followed by the placement, the club and the number of entries in the stake. Long names are misspelled to shorten.

A very successful spring season is now past, long past. And here are the big winners. Any dog with four or more placements is mentioned and all new field trial champions are duly noted.



These qualifications will be effective for the National Trials of 1964.




